

Final stage PhD funding

The Department of Sports and Health Sciences awards funding to highly qualified female doctoral candidates who are about to graduate and have no ongoing funding. The department would like to support doctoral candidates with unforeseen gaps in funding and encourage their successful PhD qualification. The diversity officer will be happy to advise you on this funding measure before you apply.

Description of the programme

Eligible candidates can receive funding in form of a part-time (max. 65%) research position for up to six months.

The focus of this research position is on the successful completion of the doctoral project. The dissertation needs to be submitted before the end of funding period. In addition, the doctoral candidate must prepare a final report after the end of the funding period.

Application process

Applications can be submitted at any time to the diversity officer. Following documents need to be included:

- Motivation letter
- Curriculum vitae
- Certificates of awarded academic degrees
- Comprehensive working plan, detailing the work done so far and the objectives for the funding period
- Reference of the supervising professor in regard to the research project and prospect of successful completion during the funding period

Application committee

The decision is made by the Diversity Committee of the department.
