Writing and upload of a protocol

The student acknowledges that a Master Thesis at the Professorship of Public Health and Prevention generally comprises the pre-specification of a research protocol (“review protocol” or “analysis plan”) during the first months of the thesis processing time, which can be publicly made available to the research community through the Open Science Framework account of the Professorship for transparency reasons. Generally, the student will be mentioned publicly as first author of this protocol unless the student does not wish to be and therefore otherwise agreed upon on an individual basis.

Sharing the final work

The student is aware that after submission and grading, his/her/their Master Thesis may be shared by Professorship employees with other students or project partners to support scientific knowledge transfer.

Publication

Should a decision be made to attempt publication of the Master Thesis results, the ICMJE authorship guidelines will be followed. If a student is not interested or engaged in the process of advancing the work for a journal publication after it has been submitted as a Master Thesis to TUM, the supervisor can decide to pursue publication without further student engagement. In this case, the student can decide if he/she wants to be mentioned as a coauthor (as long as the ICMJE criteria are fulfilled), in the acknowledgement section, or not at all.
